	e Board of Directors	
	 Martin the general manger from UL Student life is here to run through the Annual budget for the UL Student Life and get feedback that will be brought to the Board of Directors next meeting. This will be brought to the board of directors and then will be updated at the next council meeting. Martin shared the budget that would be prepared for the year and would be then ratified at the board of directors. Currently we receive €100 per undergraduate, and currently we will be looking for €110 per undergraduate when we move to the new student centre. We are now getting €106 per undergrad student. Every year postgrads give the C&S money into their budget. It is roughly about €140,000 We also collect rent from other businesses around the student union such as stables, scholars etc which should be around €65,000 We also get income from events and activations in the courtyard which we estimate be to around €185,000 but this should also increase with the new student centre. We are also looking for more sponsorship throughout the year. Martin went through the breakdown of what we would need to run the student union from trainings costs, insurance and other items that we need to help run the day to day of the student's union. 	

	 Eoghan opened the floor for questions on the budget. Jack asked around the C&S money with the hopeful increase of the budget would be very beneficial to the C&S teams. Martin spoke that a new meeting with UL in the new year will be looking for extra funding from C&S as there is currently no funding from UL going to the C&S teams. d.	Grassroots movement	Eoghan/ Kasper	10 mins
	 The housing action group is a grassroot movement as it was set up outside the union. It is an organisation that is about mobilising students on actions around accommodation since its been 18 years since UL built accommodation. Housing action group are looking for UL Student life to join them and get action happen on campus and help them when it comes to speaking with the university, as currently UL Student life are always dealing with the university Kasper is here to ask for UL Student life to help them with their plans. He is the founding member of the housing actin group. Ronan agreed with Kasper on what he spoke about around the issue faced by students and spoke on the open day demonstration. Ronan mentioned that if a person in council would like the officers to do a demonstration that they can come to council and present their idea to council for a vote, should it pass it will be actioned on then by the officers and student council. Ronan pointed out that while he will listen to a student who emails about issues it would be better understood if 50 students email about the same issue that there is an issue and will bring both issues to council should they be relevant. Jack brought the point that people actually don't bring their issues to council or to the officers, as it is because they don't know who to go to. Karen spoke to Ronan about creating a protest for the BDS movement on campus. Kye (student in attendance) spoke on the reach we have with the media and that they
